DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for completing New Employee On-boarding consisting of training on the proper guidelines, procedures, and usage of chemicals and equipment during and on an ongoing basis.
- Must have own reliable transportation to specific contract site locations.
- Ability to meet attendance work schedule with dependability and consistency. Tardiness and absences from work will place hardship on fellow team members and disrupt contracted sites cleaning schedule.
- Adheres to all company policies and procedures paying special attention to health and/or safety procedures in accordance with the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA).
- Maintains an environment that is comfortable, positive, and free of unlawful discrimination and sexual harassment.
- Adhere to existing working practices, methods, procedures, undertake relevant training and development activities and to respond positively to new and alternative systems.
- To use various types of equipment, materials, and chemicals. All equipment should be inspected to ensure good, safe working order, regularly cleaned and maintained.
- Ability to operate and maintain all equipment to include vacuum cleaners, trashcans, mop buckets, and cleaning supplies. Ensures all equipment and supplies are stored in appropriate areas.
- Sweeping, dusting, waxing, mopping, and scrubbing; washing windows, walls, and floors.
- Clean and disinfect sinks, countertops, floors, toilet, mirrors, tables, refrigerators, microwaves, etc.
- Empty trash cans and recyclables into disposal area.
- Clean and polish furniture and fixtures, deep sweep and dust.
- Clean windows, glass partitions, and mirrors, using soapy water or other cleaners, sponges, and squeegees, vacuum, steam clean, or shampoo carpets.
- Wipe down walls and woodwork, doors, wall hangings, baseboards, wash interior & exterior window glass.
- Vacuum, Steam clean or shampoo carpets.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
